16"x10.5" plus seam allowances

COLOR NOTES:

Colors a-k: Collect several fabrics in **low-key, dusty (not bright), medium** gold, brown, burgundy, red, peach. All colors should show up nicely against the dark gray (**gy**) background color. Order them so that they show up well next to each other. Assign each a letter; paste a small bit into the fabric palette to help you remember. (Any browns should not be the same as the two browns already asked for in the block.)

bpp: This stands for **soft, light-medium** blue/purple/pink. If you have one, try to use a fabric with all three colors in it. If not, two out of three (or even one) is fine. The **pk** you use must show up against it.

BEFORE BEGINNING TO SEW:

For Section R, rotary cut a piece of **br1** to 1½"x16½". After all other sections are joined, use a ¼" seam to add it to the bottom of the block.

BASIC STEPS:

1. Cut out pattern and paper piece sections, making sure to add all seam allowances as you go. A little glue stick on the wrong side of the fabric will help keep the larger pieces tighter to the pattern, and easier to piece and join.
2. After all sections are covered with fabric, turn them paper-side up and figure out how the pieces fit together. Work alphabetically following the piecing order. Make sure that the lettering on all pattern pieces is right-side up and that arrowheads match appropriately between sections.
3. Sew sections together carefully according to the piecing order. Trim seams between sections to ¼" and press to one side. Press open the seam between D-E.
4. Send me an email and tell me what you see! Include your name and city, state/province, and country (if not the U.S.).

FINISHING:

Press. Trim block to 16½"x11", which includes seam allowances.

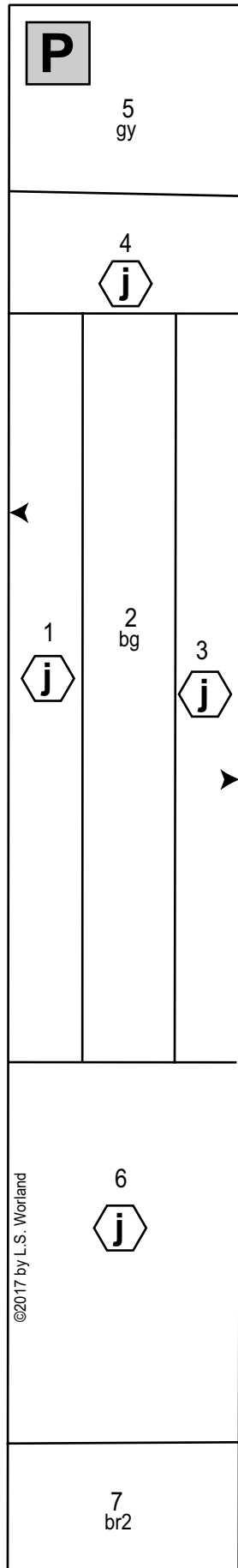
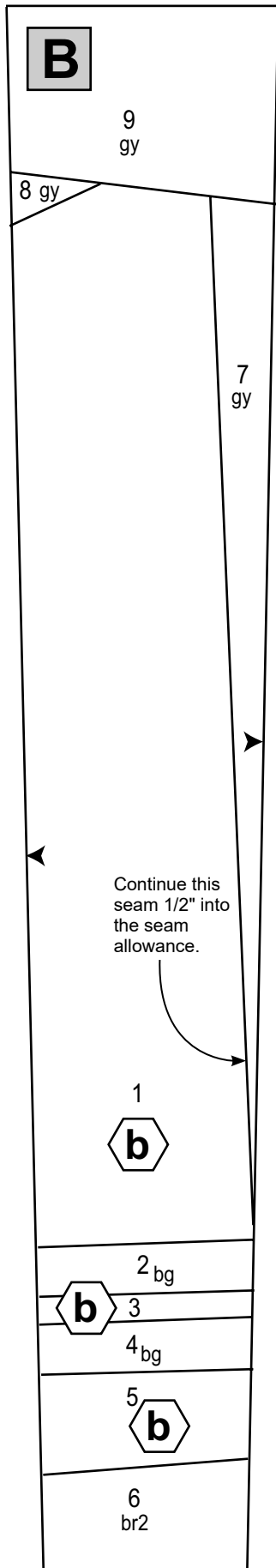
PIECING ORDER

SUGGESTED FABRIC PALETTE:

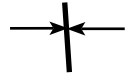
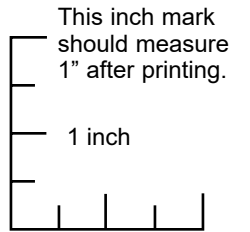

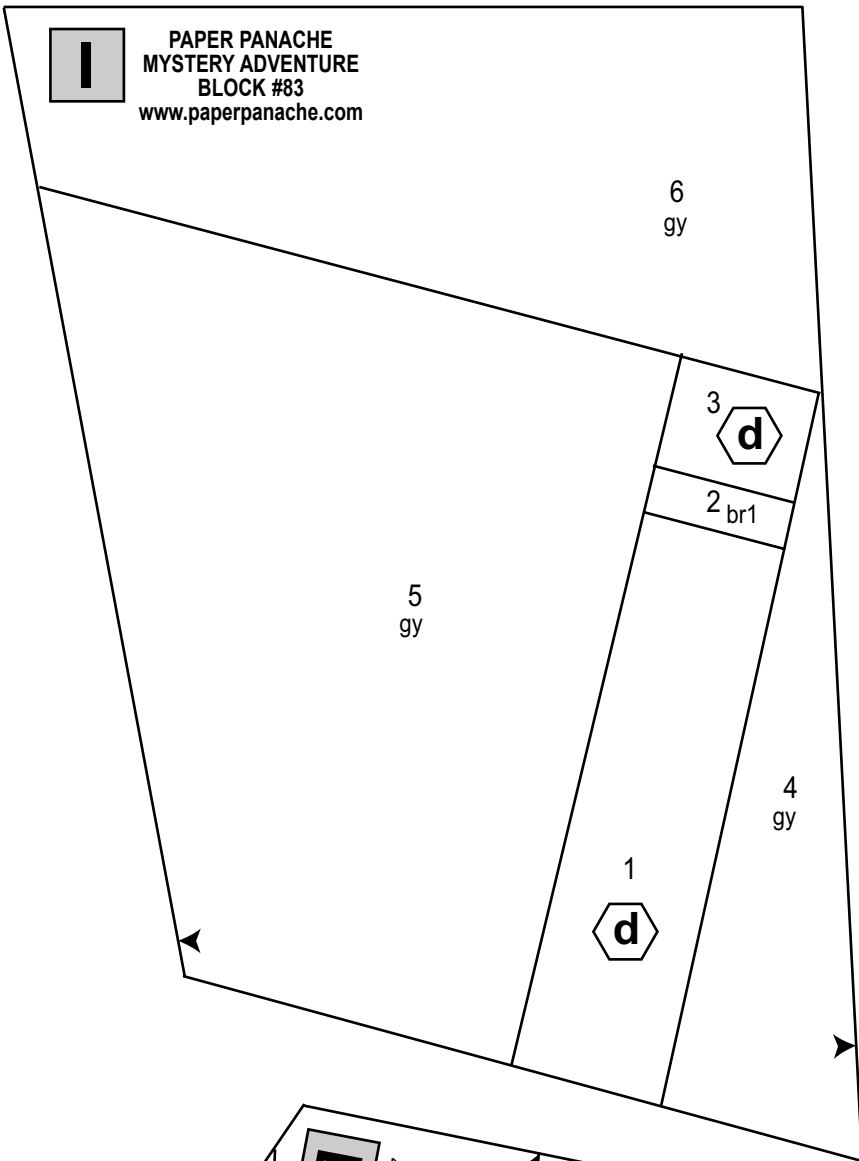
Match seams where arrowheads meet.
